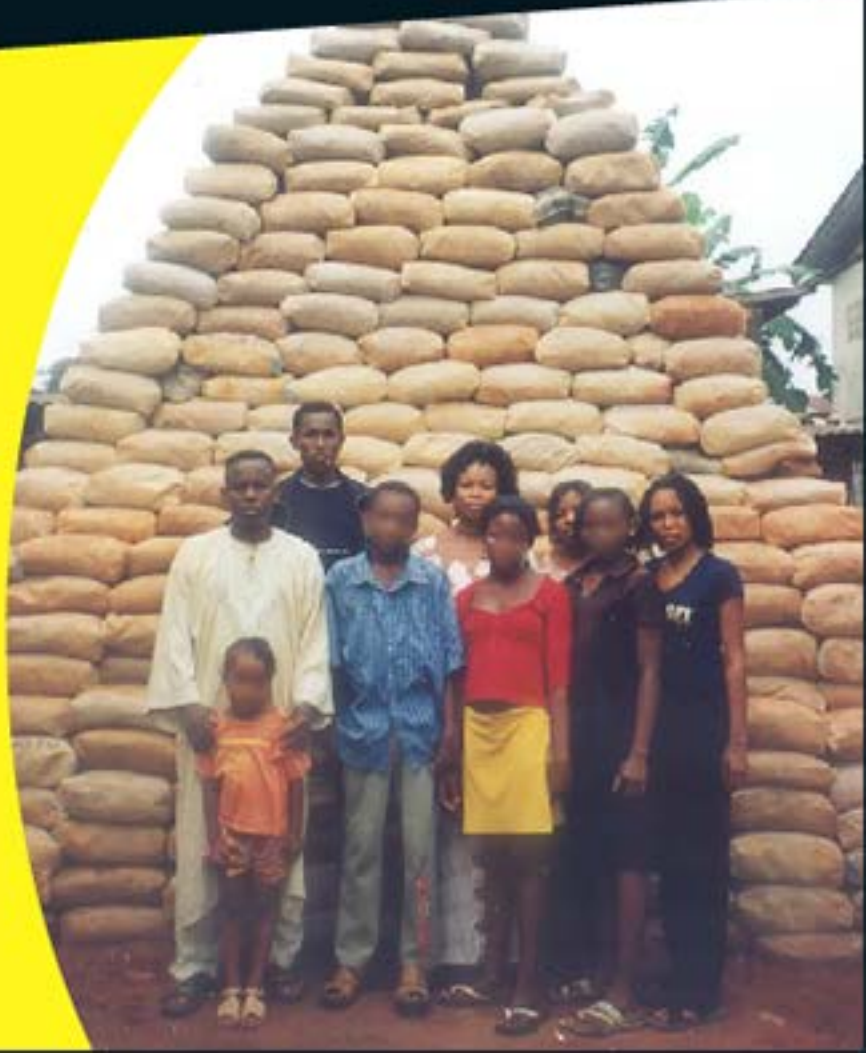

Introduction

Recently, there has been a sudden increase in TWAT sightings. What is a TWAT you might ask? A TWAT is a scammer who has decided to turn his life around and follow the path of the pious and the righteous by joining The Watchtower Apocalyptic Testament (TWAT).

TWAT was the creation of baiter extraordinaire Big Worm and yours truly. In a matter of about 60 minutes, we dreamed up the idea of a church, complete with its name, its location, appearance, and mission. We wanted to create a church so credible, and so attractive, that most any lad would want to join it. There would be a substantial financial motivation for joining it in the form of grants to help the church grow in countries where TWAT did not currently exist. We are creating this thread now in the hopes that more of you will help spread TWAT. We invite you to use all of the resources that we have created.

Basic TWAT Materials

The TWAT website

We took our time putting together the materials that would make TWAT look like a successful church. We started with a website www.securewebdata.com/TWAT/index.html. We were very particular about adding a lot of content. Big Worm and I are both very good at using Adobe Photoshop, so we both created the images that appear throughout the TWAT website. Many of you will recognize the famed Luxor Hotel and Resort in Las Vegas, Nevada as the TWAT cathedral.

Out going voice mail message

Big Worm works at a company that produces high-end video presentations and commercials for television. He has access to all sorts of excellent equipment for video and audio editing. Naturally, we took advantage of this opportunity. I wrote a script for a 15-minute outgoing answering machine message that would be guaranteed to sound completely legitimate, drive the lads insane over its length, and provide huge laughs for anyone who knows better. Big Worm used every tool available to him to produce the best outgoing voice mail message I have ever heard, complete with production quality music in the background. Membership Application

Next, we created the Membership Application to join TWAT. It is a PDF file that the lads will need to print out, fill in, scan, and email back to you. All of this will cost your lads plenty of time and money. All of our PDF files are password protected. The password is CDXIX. Yes. That is 419 in Roman numerals. Pyramid Construction Manual

Once your TWAT is a member, you will want to offer them the opportunity to receive a grant to help spread TWAT in their country. Before TWAT hands out piles of money, the lads are required to construct piles of sandbags, better known as Monuments of Faith. Since building a Monument of Faith requires careful attention and precise construction methodologies, we produced the Pyramid Construction Manual. Again, this PDF file will require the CDXIX password to open. Give it to your lads to ensure that their Monuments of Faith

Ordainment Ritual

If your lad has gone through all of the backbreaking trouble of building a Monument of Faith, you may as well invite him to become a TWAT minister. Becoming a TWAT minister is actually quite easy compared to building a sandbag pyramid. You will find the ordainment procedures here http://scambaitingtools.com/modality_archive/TWAT/ordination.pdf If your lad can follow directions, you will have one of the funniest videos you have ever seen, complete with a lad performing his "Leap of Faith", backwards off of the top of his pyramid, into the arms of his waiting flock below, while holding a flaming torch in his hand, providing plenty of chances for things to go horribly wrong.

Your lad is now ready for anything. You own him. At this point, he has totally devoted himself to TWAT. You will be able to ask him to do anything, and he will do it.

How do I start?

Use the scripts below to get started. We have tested them on many lads and they work great. You might want to tweak small things here or there but listen carefully- do not let the lads change church procedures or rules. This is the most important piece of advice that we can give you.

Your first email to the lad

Dear Brother in Christ,

We got your email. Unfortunately, we are unable to help you. Our church states that we can only do business with other members. If you were a member that would be one thing but since you are not, there is nothing that I or anyone can do here. Sorry about that.

If you wanted to become a member, there may be a great many opportunities to do something together, including helping you with your affairs.

Recently, our church was all set to begin an expansion into West Africa, Nigeria to be exact. A member of only one month had promised to help us start a new congregation in Lagos. He had completed all of the necessary steps to begin and was about to receive an initial \$200,000.00 to get started. Then, without warning, we never heard from him again. This was a great disappointment for us. If you wanted to take his place, we would be very eager to talk to you about that.

All you need to do is download Acrobat Reader. It is the most used document program in the world. I am surprised you have never seen it before. Helpful Tips

We have been TWAT baiting for over a year now. We have had many successful and entertaining safaris, several glorious Monuments of Faith, and more laughs than we ever imagined. Along the way, we discovered some things that will help you in your quest to spread TWAT.

Tip #1 - Stick to the church rules

The lads will try to get you to make exceptions to the church rules. Do not get into arguments with the lads. Just politely explain that you cannot help them if they do not want to comply with church doctrine. If they want to become a TWAT, they will do what you tell them.

Tip #2 - Get progression photos

When the lad agrees to construct his Monument of Faith, make sure to request photos during construction, not just the finished product. If you don't do this, you will get pathetic 2 dimensional triangles, not 3 dimensional pyramids as the manual describes.

Tip #3 - Remain firm on the pyramid specs

If the pyramid is in fact 3D, it is doubtful that the first photos you will receive will be of a pyramid that is 3 meters high. They all try to do the least amount of work at first.

Tip #4 - Never take the blame

Make sure to blame the rules. Never personally take a stand on anything that the lad does or asks for. You are never in authority to do anything they want. Always blame the church rules, your immediate supervisor, the committee, etc.

Tip #5 - Have a lot of characters

In any big organization, there is always a lot of bureaucracy. A church as large as TWAT is no exception. This will only slow things down for the lad and further frustrate him.

Church Baiting in General

Church baiting provides opportunities to have the lads do things that no other form of baiting can do. Why? Because religious beliefs do not have to make sense. Look closely at any of the world's religions and you will find all sorts of doctrine that has little foundation in logic. So, asking a lad to build an 80 tons sandbag pyramid on his dime makes total sense. So does getting a tattoo, going on a pilgrimage, baptizing himself in tar, throwing himself off a mountain, etc.

You may find yourself struggling at times with a little bit of guilt. Sometimes, you will find lads that really believe that they are about to start a church. They have dropped scamming completely and see TWAT as a way to lead a decent and comfortable life. This can be uncomfortable for some people to totally jerk around someone like this. These ethical dilemmas are easy to deal with. If you don't feel comfortable making a fool out of a lad who thinks that he is truly doing something good, then just stop.

You will want to be sure that your lad is in fact a scammer once in a while. This is also an easy thing to do. Once you start a church bait, whether it's TWAT or another fake church, bait the lad as a different character. You will usually see that while the lad is trying to become a minister, he is at the very same time trying to rob you blind. If this does not give you the moral flexibility to bait this guy to the stone age, then nothing will. Quit baiting and go do something else.
